1. How many restrictions did God place on the Garden of Eden?

a. 0.

Sorry, that is incorrect. Well... God did say not to eat something...

b. 1.

Correct! The answer is "b"!

God commanded only one prohibition: "from any tree of the garden you may eat freely; but from the tree of knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat,..." (Gen 2:16-17).

c. 2.

Sorry, that is incorrect. Actually it was Woman who suggested that there were two prohibitions.

"The woman said to the serpent, 'From the fruit of the trees of the garden we may eat; but from the fruit of the tree which is in the middle of the garden, God has said, 'You shall not eat from it or touch it, or you will die.''" (Gen 3:2-3)

d. 3.

Sorry, that is incorrect. God only placed one prohibition.

"The Lord God commanded the man, saying, 'From any tree of the garden you may eat freely; but from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat from it you will surely die.'" (Gen 2:16-17)

2. When did God make his command "not to eat of the fruit from the tree of knowledge of good and evil?"

a. Day 7 of Creation.

Sorry, that is incorrect. God rested on this day.

b. Before Adam was created.

Sorry, that is incorrect. If Adam wasn't created, who was God speaking to??!

c. Before Woman was created.

Correct! The answer is "c"!

God commanded Adam "not to eat of the fruit from the tree of knowledge of good and evil" before Woman was even created.

d. At the end of day 6 of Creation.

Sorry, that is incorrect. At the end of day 6, Woman was already created. God's command was given to Adam before Woman was created.

3. What was the cause of Woman's sin?

a. She was uncertain of God's Word.

Correct! The answer is "a"!

Woman was uncertain of God's Word. Had she known God's Word, as Jesus demonstrated when Satan tempted Him, she would not have succumbed to her lusts. While God commanded Adam "not to eat" the fruit, Woman added to the prohibition by saying, "or touch it"

"The woman said to the serpent, 'From the fruit of the trees of the garden we may eat; but from the fruit of the tree which is in the middle of the garden, God has said, 'You shall not eat from it or touch it, or you will die.''" (Gen 3:2-3)

b. She saw the tree as delightful and its fruit beautiful.

Sorry, that is incorrect. While the tree was tempting, that was not the cause of her disobedience.

c. She wanted to be the leader of the family unit.

Sorry, that is incorrect. That was not the cause of her sin!

d. All of the above.

Sorry, that is incorrect. Since "b" and "c" are incorrect, "d" is incorrect as well.
