**What names did God call Jesus by?
Teacher Notes**

Do your parents have more than one name for you? What do those names reflect? God calls Jesus different names to tell us different aspects about Him? What do you see and learn? What name for Jesus do you like?

Briefly ask the student what names his parents call him by and why. This will prepare him for this lesson.

Read the various passages and encourage the student's skill of observation.

She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins." All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had said through the prophet: "The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and they will call him **Immanuel**" (which means "**God with us**"). (Matt 1:21-23 [Isa 7:14], NIV)

Ask the student: what is God telling us with the name Immanuel / God with us?

Consider what the apostle John says, "No one has ever seen God, but the one and only Son, who is himself God and is in closest relationship with the Father, has made him known." (John 1:18, NIV)

God is telling us that He is a historically real person as seen through His Son Jesus.

**Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God,
Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.** (Isa 9:6, NIV)

Ask the student: what is God telling us with the name Wonderful Counselor? Mighty God? Everlasting Father? Prince of Peace? Do these names give you any comfort? Why?

Awake, awake, **arm of the Lord**,
clothe yourself with strength!

Awake, as in days gone by,
as in generations of old.

Was it not you who cut Rahab to pieces,

Ask the student: what is God telling us with the name Arm of the Lord? What image do you see when you flex your arm?

This is the name by which he will be called:

The Lord Our Righteous Savior. (Jer 23:5-6, NIV)

Ask the student: what is God telling us with the name Lord Our Righteous Savior?

The definition for “righteous” is doing what is right in God’s eyes or obeying God’s word.

“I will send my messenger, who will prepare the way before me. Then suddenly the Lord you are seeking will come to his temple; the messenger of the covenant, whom you desire, will come,” says the Lord Almighty. (Mal 3:1, NIV)

Ask the student: what is God telling us with the name Messenger of the Covenant? What covenant is God referring to?

Ask the student: what is God telling us with the name Horn of Salvation? What does a horn do or signify?

Ask the student: what is God telling us with the name Rising Sun from Heaven?
