The Christmas Story - The Shepherds (Luke 2:6-16)
Teacher Notes

Video Abstract (Author: Max7.org): A short narration of the story of the shepherds after Jesus' birth, from Luke 2:8-16. It is suitable for children from about 4 years of age.

Read Luke 2:6-16 dramatically to the students:

and while they were there, she gave birth to her first-born son. She dressed him in baby clothes and laid him on a bed of hay, because there was no room for them in the inn.

That night in the fields near Bethlehem some shepherds were guarding their sheep. All at once an angel came down to them from the Lord, and the brightness of the Lord's glory flashed around them. The shepherds were frightened. But the angel said, "Don't be afraid! I have good news for you, which will make everyone happy. This very day in King David's hometown a Savior was born for you. He is Christ the Lord. You will know who he is, because you will find him dressed in baby clothes and lying on a bed of hay."

Suddenly many other angels came down from heaven and joined in praising God. They said:

"Praise God in heaven!
Peace on earth to everyone who pleases God."

After the angels had left and gone back to heaven, the shepherds said to each other, "Let's go to Bethlehem and see what the Lord has told us about." They hurried off and found Mary and Joseph, and they saw the baby lying on a bed of hay. (Luke 2:6-16, CEV)

1. What do angels look like? Draw what you imagine!

Note to teacher: The Bible does not depict regular angels as having wings. Only a special class of angels have wings, cherubim (Ex 25:18-20) and seraphim (Isa 6:2-6).

2. Watch the video. What do angels do? Cross out the incorrect type of angel:

"Don't be afraid!"

These angels are good | evil.

"I have good news for you, which will make everyone happy!"

Good | Evil angels are very happy that Jesus was born.
